Date : **November 5, 2021**

The Commission on Higher Education and the Unified Student Financial Assistance System for Tertiary Education launched two projects with the Film Development Center of the Philippines (FDCP) that would be part of the advocacy to promote the benefits and successes of the programs under RA 10931 (Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Act) particularly the Free Higher Education and Tertiary Education Subsidy programs through webinar-based training on digital media content creation (**#MyKwentongCHEDUniFAST**) and a short film lab (**Cinelskool**).

#MyKwentongCHEDUniFAST seeks to provide our beneficiaries with a platform to create digital content which would enable them to play a role in influencing others to pursue higher education. The project will be conducted in two (2) stages. First, the Vlogging Webinar Series will be orchestrated by digital content influencers and vloggers who will tackle topics on effective editing and choosing the perfect filming equipment. The second stage will begin with the launch of the Vlogging Portal where participants may submit their vlogs and exhibit their experiences as advocates of the RA 10931.
