In reference to the Memorandum issued by Chairman J. Prospero De Vera III dated September 10, 2018 requiring all Higher Education Institutions to submit the list of enrolled students for the 1st Semester of Academic Year 2018-2019 for the nationwide assessment of TES applicants, and upon completion of the process of importing the data into the TES Online Portal on midnight of 30 October 2018, the UniFAST conducted a nationwide assessment of all TES applicants in accordance with the TES Guidelines to properly select the qualified TES beneficiaries.

The UniFAST Secretariat and ICT Team has completed the assessment of TES applicants and produced the list of qualified TES grantees. The result of the assessment process was presented, reviewed and properly deliberated by the members of the UniFAST Board during its 17th Governing Board meeting on November 22, 2018 at Chair's Conference Room, 4/F HEDC Bldg., C.P. Garcia, Diliman, Quezon City.

Upon the recommendation of the UniFAST Secretariat and members of the UniFAST Governing Board, Chairman Dr. J. Prospero E. De Vera III approved the Masterlist of TES grantees under Listahanan 2.0 identified by the Department of Social Work and Development.



In this regard, the UniFAST Secretariat requests the Presidents/Officers-in-Charge of SUCs and CHED-Recognized LUCs to attend the above-mentioned activity for the distribution of TES benefits to State Universities and Colleges and CHED-Recognized Local Universities and Colleges whose students enrolled in AY 2018-2019 are granted with the *Tertiary Education Subsidy* under RA 10931. The event shall take place at the CHED Auditorium on Tuesday, December 18, 2018 from 9AM to 1PM.
