During the 22nd Regular Meeting of the UniFAST Governing Board on May 23, 2019, the body approved the grant of benefits under RA 10931 to twenty seven (27) Local Universities and Colleges that were issued CHED Recognition pursuant to Commission en Banc Resolution No. 247-2019. The additional CHED-Recognized Local Universities and Colleges shall be eligible to implement the programs of RA 10931 starting Academic Year 2019-2021, subject to the existing laws, policies, guidelines and implementing rules and regulations governing the programs under RA 10931 entitled "Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education".



The 27 CHED-Recognized LUCs shall be invited to the Signing Ceremony on the Memorandum of Agreement with CHED-UniFAST and orientation on the programs of RA 10931 that shall be announced by the UniFAST Secretariat as soon as we get confirmation on the available schedule of the Chair. The Presidents/Heads of the newly CHED-Recognized LUCs are advised to communicate with the CHEDRO-Higher Education Management Information System (HEMIS) to secure information about their respective HEI Code so that they can immediately register their programs/courses in the CHED Registry of Quality-Assured Institutions and Programs.

The Presidents/Heads of these institutions are also advised to submit the names of their TES Focal Person to the UniFAST Secretariat through the CHED Regional Directors. The UniFAST Regional Coordinators will issue the user credentials (Username and Password) to the TES Focal Persons so that they may be able to access the UniFAST TES Online Portal. All UniFAST Regional Coordinators are instructed to assist the Presidents/Heads and designated TES Focal Persons of the 27 newly CHED-Recognized LUCs and provide the needed technical support in creating the respective accounts of LUCs in the TES Online Portal.
